

Dr. **Jacqueline Junkins-Hopkins** is a Dermatologist/Dermatopathologist, who received her Medical School training at the Johns Hopkins Hospital, where she also completed a residency in Internal Medicine, prior to training in Dermatology at the University of Virginia and Dermatopathology at Harvard Medical School.
