

Dr. Rajiv M. Patel is Associate Professor of Pathology and Dermatology at the University of Michigan in Ann Arbor, MI, USA. He received his M.D. degree from Flinders University School of Medicine in Adelaide, Australia and completed his residency training in pathology at Cleveland Clinic, where he served as Anatomic Pathology Chief Resident. Dr. Patel completed fellowships in surgical pathology and soft tissue pathology, the latter under the direction of Dr. Sharon Weiss, at Emory University and dermatopathology under the direction of Dr. Wilma Bergfeld at Cleveland Clinic. He is board certified in anatomic pathology and dermatopathology and is the Director of the Bone & Soft Tissue Pathology Fellowship at the University of Michigan and Associate-Director of the National Institutes of Health (NIH) Sarcoma Alliance for Research through Collaboration (SARC) Specialized Program of Research Excellence (SPORE) Biospecimen Core. Dr. Patel is an Assistant Editor for the Journal of Cutaneous Pathology and an Editorial Board Member of The American Journal of Dermatopathology and Pathology Journal of the Royal Australasian College of Pathologists. He has authored over 60-peer-reviewed publications and has lectured and directed courses on soft tissue pathology and dermatopathology for the American Society of Dermatopathology, the United States and Canadian Academy of Pathology, the American Academy of Dermatology and the International Society of Dermatopathology. He serves on numerous committees including those of the United States and Canadian Academy of Pathology, the College of American Pathologists and the American Society of Dermatopathology where he is also the Member-at-Large Director of the Board of Directors.
