

Dr. **Wayne Grayson** obtained his undergraduate medical degree from the University of the Free State in South Africa (S.A). He received his specialist training in Anatomical Pathology at the University of the Witwatersrand, Johannesburg (WITS) and the S.A. Institute for Medical Research, and was awarded a PhD in 2001.
